

GHSA SouthCentral Year End High Point Program



Eligibility requirements for GHSA SouthCentral Eligibility requirements for Year End High Point:

- 1.) Must be a current member of GHSA BEFORE points are awarded.
- 2.) One Horse/One Rider rules apply for Amateur, AOE, Youth. Open is based upon the horse.
- 3.) Exhibitors placing in top 6 will be awarded points for each placing below them, not to exceed 6 pts for 1st place.

- 4.) Year End Divisions: (Divisions at each show will vary depending on budget)
 - a. Open WJ/WT
 - b. Open WJC/WJL
 - c. Open Halter
 - d. Amateur/AOE WJ/WT
 - e. Amateur/AOE WTC/WJL
 - f. Amateur/AOE Halter
 - g. Youth WJ/WT
 - h. Youth WTC/WJL
 - i. Youth Halter
 - j. Overall Youth 10 and Under (Halter and Under Saddle combined)

Points from Amateur and AOE will be combined, if a competitor enters both Amateur and AOE only one set of points will be counted toward the Year End High Point, highest cumulated total will be used

- 5.) To be eligible for the Year End High Point Amateur/AOE WJ/WT, Amateur/AOE WTC/WJL, Youth WJ/WT and Youth WTC/WJL, horse/rider combo must show in a minimum of **6 under saddle classes in your division each show and must show at 2 of the 3 shows (El Reno, OK., McKinney TX., and Chickasha, OK.**
- 6.) Only one award can be won by a horse/rider combo. If a second award is won by the same person, the rider/handler will receive the award won in division with lesser horses. If second award is won then it will move to the next place horse/rider combo or horse (in Open) in that division as a Reserve award.
- 7.) FOR GHSA SouthCentral: MUST work & document **3 work segments per exhibitor/horse pair, per year.** Ex: You show 2 horses and are competing for a year end high point with both, then 6 segments total are required.

WORK SEGMENT INFO FOR YEAR END AWARD ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for GHSA SouthCentral year end awards, exhibitors **MUST** be current GHSA member **AND MUST** complete 3 work segments per exhibitor.

- a. Exhibitors may sign up at the office to work any of the following:
 - i. Award Handout, pass out ribbons, champion awards or prizes for at least ½ day at any given show
 - ii. Ring Assistant - Set up for classes. Work in the arena to set up/reset/tear down obstacles for pattern, ranch and/or trail classes.
 - iii. Return judge cards to office every 3-4 classes.
 - iv. Pay Out - Exhibitors may pay for their segments at \$30 each. Must be paid before points are counted.
 - v. Sponsorships - Exhibitors may recruit sponsorships. Sponsorships over \$125 will count as segments worked.
 - vi. EXTRA - Exhibitors may also work “other” segments, if requested and agreed to by both GHSA Board of Directors or Show Management. Ex: Someone to volunteer to bring ice in evenings/show mornings, bring snacks, pick up judge lunches, etc. NOTE: “Other” segments must be equivalent to at least \$30 for each segment.
- b. There will be a signup sheet in the office at each show. Exhibitors may have a family member or friend work their segments for them, be sure to note who you are working for on the signup sheet. It is the member’s responsibility to document their work segments, show management and board of directors will not be responsible for making sure your segments are documented at the show
- c. **Must have 3 work credits per exhibitor/horse pair, per year to be eligible for GHSA SouthCentral Year End Awards!**
