Classes: \$30 All Open and Amateur Classes and "Buy A Class"

Youth: \$15/class per horse/rider combo, 7 or more classes- \$100 (Applies to youth classes only)

Office Fee: \$30/horse (not per horse/exhibitor combination)

Stall/Tack Stall Fee: \$125/Stall (Friday-Sunday)

Early arrival/ Late Departure: \$30/day/stall

GVHS Drug Testing Fee: \$20/horse

RV Hook Ups: \$30/night, All RV sites are supplied with electric and water hook-ups and are on a first-come/first serve basis.

Membership Fees: GHSA membership- At least one of the horse's owners must be a member.

Annual Adult \$35

Annual Youth \$20

Annual Family \$50

Lifetime \$500

Non-Member \$10/horse (Per GHSA Supplement Rules, waived if Show Management pays GHSA Fee)

Please note that you must be a GHSA member prior to competing in your first GHSA competition of 2026 to be eligible for the year end high point awards. (When a youth or amateur is showing, they will enter the program in the month their membership is paid, and the amateur declaration is received. Points will not be retroactive!

Rulebook:

All owners, trainers or competitors are required to read the Gypsy Vanner Horse Society Rule Book prior to the show. The rule book is located on the GVHS website. GHSA Supplement rules will be followed as well and are posted on the GHSA Website.

Horse Show Office Hours:

Friday: 12-7 pm; Saturday/Sunday: 7:00 am- last class completion, Thursday move in must be preapproved and discussed with Show Management

Awards:

Rosette ribbons or coupons will be awarded to 6th place in all classes. Coupons are redeemable toward showbill at the show office. Halter Champion and Reserve Champion rosettes. Halter Grand Champions in respective sexes returns for Supreme Halter Champion. All Lead Line participants will receive a ribbon

High Point Awards, Must be a current member of GHSA or Non-Member Fee is paid BEFORE points are awarded. Non Members are only eligible for show high points, not year end). One Horse/One Rider rules apply for Amateur and Youth. Open is based upon the horse. High Point Winners and Reserves will be awarded!

Payment:

All fees must be paid, and correct information provided before the show office will release exhibitor/horse number. Cash, check, Venmo, PayPal or credit card accepted. An open check is required if adding classes during the show. Submit PayPal payment to GHSASouth@gmail.com or Venmo @GHSASouth

Refunds: Cancellations prior to the closing date will be refunded minus the office and stall fees (Closing date is 7 days prior to the first day of the show). No refunds of any kind for any reason will be given after the closing date (even if the closing date is extended) and throughout the competition. Absolutely NO refunds will be given at the show.

Health Requirements

A negative Coggins drawn within the last 12 months. Include a copy of Coggins with entries and bring to show office upon check in. Out of state horses will need a 10-day health certificate. Horses NOT competing: non-showing horses are allowed on the grounds if space is available. The owner must fill out an entry form and pay the office and stall fees. Coggins and a 10-day health certificate (out of state horses) are required.

Stabling:

Stalls are 10x10 on concrete floors. Fee is \$125 (Friday-Sunday). The stall fee does NOT include shavings. You must purchase from the facility for \$12/bag. If ordered in advance, the shavings will be near stalls upon arrival. Tack Stalls are the same price as horse stalls. On the entry form, list the total number of stalls you will need. Availability: Friday at 8 am until Sunday at 11:59 pm. Early arrival on Thursday at 12 pm/noon and/or late departure on Monday morning is available for \$30/day/stall (UPON SHOW MANAGEMENT PRIOR APPROVAL, PLEASE INQUIRE). Please note stall groups on entry form. Who you would like to stable near or with.

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Show Operations and Misc Guidelines:

Show Management reserves the right to cancel classes insufficiently filled and to refuse or require withdrawal of an entry from a class due to Rule Book violations.

Show Management reserves the right to revise the show schedule. The class list provided is in chronological order and is the actual class order. If adjustments need to be made an announcement will be given to all exhibitors. Lunch breaks are at the discretion of the Judge and Show Management and will be announced.

Show Management reserves the right to change officials, limit entries, divide, combine, add or cancel classes and modify the schedule as required.

Scratches During the Show Competitors have the responsibility to inform Show Secretary in the Show Office of their intent to scratch a ride prior to the scheduled ride time. Scratches will be accepted at the competition arena or with the Gate Steward but the competitor or representative must contact the show office to officially scratch the ride. Scratched classes are not refundable.

Horse under saddle or in harness must not have their sight impaired by their forelock (band or braid it).

Please refer to the GVHS Rule Book for appropriate attire and tack for classes. If in doubt, ASK.

The failure of an exhibitor to wear the correct number and/or in a visible manner will be given one warning before being disqualified in subsequent classes. Back numbers stay with the horse and will be the same throughout the competition regardless of exhibitor.

Riders in 9 and under classes are allowed an attendant.

Protests, charges and grievances should be directed to the Show Manager for resolution but all decisions by the judge(s) are final.

Well-mannered dogs are allowed on the grounds but **MUST ALWAYS** be leashed.

Hazardous Weather/Accident Policy:

Show Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, conditions outside of show managements controls, accidents, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule. No refund for cancellations due to hazardous weather, unforeseen hazards, accidents or emergencies.
