Fees

• All Open, Amateur, AOE Classes: \$30/class

Youth-\$15/class per horse, 7 or more classes-\$100 (Applies to youth classes only)

Office Fee: \$30/horse (not per horse/exhibitor combination)

Stall/Tack Fee: \$120/Stall (Friday-Sunday)

Shavings: \$11

Early arrival/ Late Departure: \$30/day/stall

Late Entry Fee: \$35 plus regular fees (if entering after closing date on September 28, 2025)

 - Please note that you must be a GHSA member prior to competing in your first GHSA competition of 2025 to be eligible for the year end high point awards. (When a youth or amateur is showing, they will enter the program in the month their membership is paid, and the amateur declaration is received. Points will not be retroactive!

Awards

- Rosette ribbons or coupons will be awarded to 6th place in all classes.
- Champion and Reserve Champion rosettes
- All Lead Line participants will receive a ribbon.

Payments

- Mail entry forms and check (checks made payable to "Gypsy Horse Show Association") to GSHA c/o Sherri Jolliff 12030 St. Rt. JJ, West Plains, MO 65775 **OR** email entries to cornerstoneshowmgt@yahoo.com along with a check or valid credit card information.
- Refunds: Cancellations prior to the closing date will be refunded minus the office fees.
- Horses <u>NOT</u> competing: non-showing horses are allowed on the grounds if space is available. The owner must fill out an entry form and pay the office and stall fees. Coggins and a 10-day health certificate (out-of-state horses) are required.
- All fees must be paid, and correct information provided before the show office will release exhibitor/horse number.
- Cash, check or credit card accepted. An open check is required if you are adding classes during the show.

Rule Book

• All owners, trainers or competitors are required to read the Gypsy Vanner Horse Society Rule Book prior to the show. The rule book is located on the GVHS website.

• Online entries may be made at <u>www.horseshowing.com</u>. Create a login and access 2025 GHSA Region I Championship Show from the shows tab.

Camping

• All 87 camp sites are supplied with electric and water hook-ups and are on a first-come/ first serve basis. There is a dump station on the grounds.

Entry and Horse Registry

- At least one owner of the full-bred Gypsy Vanner/Gypsy Horse to be shown must be a paid member of the Gypsy Horse Show Association. Otherwise, a non-member fee of \$10 per horse will be assessed at each show.
- Current registration papers verifying current gender, age and ownership must be submitted with entries. For horses being leased or purchased on a payment plan, please include a copy of the lease or contract.
- Liability waivers must be completed with all requested names/signatures.
- Horses cannot compete in any driving or riding classes until they are 3 years old.

Hospitality

- Competitor dinner is offered for Friday night for \$20/person, additional meals may be purchased in advance for family and friend, please include on entry form.
- Concessions will be available on-site on Saturday and Sunday?

Health Requirements

- A negative Coggins drawn within the last 12 months. Include a copy of Coggins with entries. You will need to show the original at the show office.
- Out-of-state horses will need a 10-day health certificate.

Stabling

- Stalls are 10x10 with gates on concrete floors. Fee is \$125 (Friday-Sunday)
- The stall fee does NOT include shavings. You must purchase from the facility for \$11/bag. If ordered in advance, the shavings will be at your stalls upon arrival.
- Tack Stalls are the same price as horse stalls. On the entry form, list the total number of stalls you will need.
- Availability: Friday from 8 am until Sunday at 11:59 pm. Early arrival on Thursday at 12 pm/noon and/or late departure on Monday morning is available for \$30/day/stall.
- Groups: Please note stall groups on the entry form.

Competition Rules

- The same horse/rider combination cannot cross enter both Walk/Jog or Walk/Trot classes and classes that require three gaits (Walk/Jog/Lope or Walk/Trot/Canter).
- Horses under saddle or in harness <u>must not</u> have their sight impaired by their forelock (band or braid it).
- Please refer to the GVHS Rule Book for appropriate attire and tack for classes. If in doubt, ASK.
- A MAIDEN horse is in its first year of showing.
- The failure of an exhibitor to wear the correct number and/or in a visible manner will be given one warning before being disqualified in subsequent classes.
- Protests, charges and grievances should be directed to the Show Manager for a resolution, but all decisions by the judge(s) are final.
- Back numbers stay with the horse and will be the same throughout the competition regardless of exhibitor.
- Riders in 9 and under classes are allowed an attendant.

Show Operations

- Show Management reserves the right to cancel classes insufficiently filled and to refuse or require withdrawal of an entry from a class due to Rule Book violations.
- Show Management reserves the right to revise start times.
- Show Management may combine or divide classes.
- Entries will not be allowed into the show arena without the correct back number.
- The class list provided is in chronological order and is the actual class order.
- Lunch, set up, tear down and preparation breaks are at the discretion of the Judge and Show Management.
- Show Management reserves the right to change officials, limit entries, combine or cancel classes and modify the schedule as required.

Refunds and Hazardous Weather Policies

- **Refund Policy** Refunds will be given from opening date up to the closing date, less the office fee and the online convenience fee. No refunds of any kind for any reason including Acts of God will be given after the closing date (even if the closing date is extended) and throughout the competition. Absolutely **NO** refunds will be given at the show.
- <u>Scratches During the Show</u> Competitors have the responsibility to inform Show Secretary in the Show Office of their intent to scratch a ride prior to the scheduled ride time. Scratches will be accepted at the competition arena or with the Gate Steward, but the competitor or representative must contact the show office to officially scratch the ride. <u>Scratched classes are not refundable!</u>
- <u>Hazardous Weather/Act of God/Accident Policy</u> Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule. No refund for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents or emergencies.


